MEMBERSHIP DUES

Is it time to renew your membership? It depends.

Many of you – but not all – will start to receive reminders to renew your AAUW membership for the new fiscal year. Your expiration date depends on when you joined. <u>There is no need to renew</u> <u>until you receive an email reminder from AAUW.</u>

How much are the dues?

Dues for most of you are \$99, which covers the following:

- Vienna Area Branch \$10
- Virginia State \$15
- National AAUW \$74

Paid life members pay only branch and state dues. Dual members pay additional dues; if you are unsure of how to renew your dual memberships, contact the Vienna Area Branch Finance Officer. Remember that the national dues are entirely tax-deductible if you itemize your deductions in 2025. State and branch dues are not deductible.

To renew online with a credit card

Go to **www.aauw.org** and click on Log In. After logging in, scroll down and click on the orange "Renew" box. From there, click to renew your National membership, your Vienna Area Branch membership, and your Virginia State membership. After transmitting your credit card information you will receive an email from AAUW acknowledging your renewal.
